The Maharashtra State Pharmacy Council (MSPC), in collaboration with the Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC), is pleased to announce the launch of a dedicated "**Pharmacovigilance & Medicine Safety**" section on the official MSPC website.

This initiative has been undertaken as part of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between IPC and MSPC to promote rational use of medicines, strengthen pharmacovigilance activities, and enhance patient safety across Maharashtra.

The newly introduced section provides easy access to important drug information and pharmacovigilance resources, including:

- National Formulary of India (NFI) access/purchase link
- Latest Drug Safety Alerts issued under the Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI)
- ADR Monitoring System (ADRMS) QR Code for quick ADR reporting
- List of Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring Centers (AMCs) in Maharashtra
- ADR Reporting Forms for Healthcare Professionals and Consumers in English, Hindi, and other vernacular languages

MSPC encourages all registered pharmacists, pharmacy students, academicians, hospital pharmacists, community pharmacists, and other healthcare professionals to regularly visit this section and actively participate in pharmacovigilance activities.

Together, let us strengthen medication safety, promote rational use of medicines, and contribute towards a safer healthcare system.
